# THE CALLER

## PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

“I was hungry and you fed me, thirsty and you gave me a drink; I was a stranger and you received me in your homes, <sup>36</sup>naked and you clothed me; I was sick and you took care of me, in prison and you visited me.’ <sup>37</sup>The righteous will then answer him, ‘When, Lord, did we ever see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you a drink? <sup>38</sup>When did we ever see you a stranger and welcome you in our homes, or naked and clothe you? <sup>39</sup>When did we ever see you sick or in prison, and visit you?’ <sup>40</sup>The King will reply, ‘I tell you, whenever you did this for one of the least important of these followers of mine, you did it for me!’ (Matthew 25: 35-40)

This is a great lesson taught by Jesus. He told the parables of many seemingly small unimportant things or people and their value to God. The following story is a great story of a little boy seeing the value in a puppy dog the store owner saw no value in. Enjoy!
